

Scholarship Opportunity

Information

High school students have the opportunity to participate in a competition to design the program cover for the 2017 Institute for CTE Educators. This design competition provides students with the chance to earn a scholarship to the Tennessee public postsecondary school of their choice.

The applicant with the winning design will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship to go towards her or his postsecondary degree and will have her or his design featured on the cover of the program, while the runner-up and second runner-up will be awarded \$500 and \$250 respectively, as well as have their designs featured inside the program.

Only one (1) design will be accepted per student. The winning high school students must attend a Tennessee public postsecondary institution following graduation in order to receive the scholarship award.

Requirements

- Design Format: Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop
- File Format: JPEG or PDF
- Colors: Full Color
- Cover size: Overall 11 x 17 folded to 8.5 X 11 for front and back cover design
- Design must include the following information on the front cover:
 - **Name of Institute:** 2017 Institute for CTE Educators
 - **Theme:** The Career Ready Student
 - **Date:** July 17–21, 2017
 - **Location:** Music City Center, Nashville, TN
 - **Sponsored by:** The Tennessee Department of Education and the Division of College, Career and Technical Education
